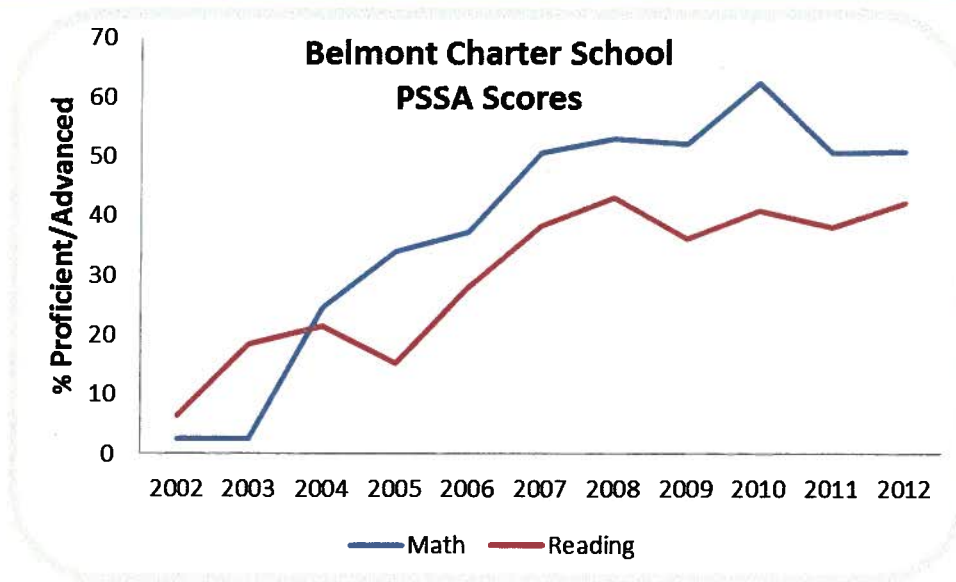


# OUR SUCCESS/RESULTS



Since Belmont Charter School became the first school district converted charter school in 2002 and has been implementing educational and social service programming, we have seen a **48.3%** growth in students scoring Proficient/Advanced in Math on the PSSAs and a **35.8%** growth of students scoring Proficient/Advanced in Reading.
