

STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS

98% of students are African American

75% of students come from single parent households

21% of our parents have identified mental health diagnoses

12% of students have identified mental health diagnoses

6% of students have suspected/untreated mental health needs

21% of students have DHS involvement in the home

8% of students live in foster/kinship care (removed from parents home)

20% of students' families are considered homeless

8% *of students currently live in a homeless shelter*

28% *of students' families were homeless at some point in the past few years*

15% of students have had an immediate family member incarcerated

8% of students have faced domestic violence occurring in their home

12% of students live in a household where there exists drug/alcohol abuse

5% of students have suffered from physical abuse

3% of students have suffered from known sexual abuse

3% of students have had a family member violently killed (gun/drug related)
