

Do you qualify for EMPOWER³?

Not everyone can take advantage of this new health care program. It was designed specifically for those hardworking people caught in the “middle” – earning too much for Medicaid and too little to afford traditional insurance.

Potential members must meet the following income levels:

Potential members will need to apply for the Medical ACCESS card and receive a denial. Our staff will assist you in this process. Potential members also need to provide proof of income that meet the income requirements. Then an appointment is scheduled for the member to establish themselves at the EMPOWER³ Center for Health. Once you are an established member of the Center, you are eligible to purchase the low cost insurance that provides you with full access to the hospital associated with the EMPOWER³ Center for Health with no deductibles or coinsurance.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is EMPOWER³ a health care insurance plan?

EMPOWER³ is an innovative healthcare program that teams up hospitals, physicians and an insurance company, to provide quality affordable health care protection for those earning too much for Medicaid, but too little for private insurance. Coverage includes hospitalization, well and sick visits, x-ray and lab, Rx and much more.

How does the program work?

Once qualified into the EMPOWER³ Center for Health, you will receive all your primary care at the Center. The Center will coordinate any needed specialty care as well. Should you need hospitalization, you will go to the partnering hospital and receive your care under the program. You may also be asked to meet with a dietitian to receive nutritional guidance and support to provide optimum good health tools.

What's the catch?

There is no "catch". The key is to have all your care provided by or coordinated by the Center and its partnering hospital. If you seek care outside these relationships then you can expect to receive bills or have uncompensated care.

I have a pre-existing condition. Does that matter?

No, it doesn't matter if you have a condition that would normally prevent you from obtaining traditional health insurance. Our program does not medically underwrite or ask any medical questions.

Can I cover my dependents?

This policy covers individuals 18 years of age or older. Children are referred to the local CHIP programs.
