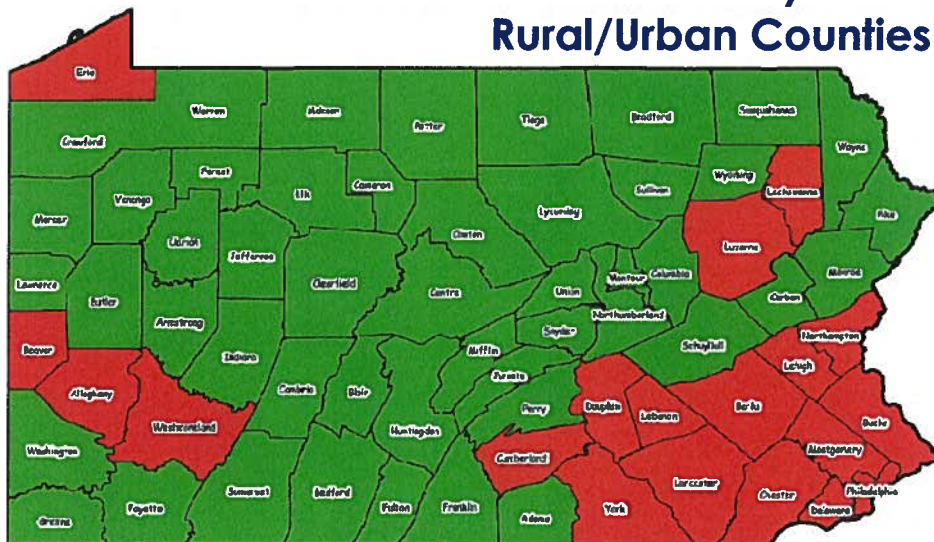

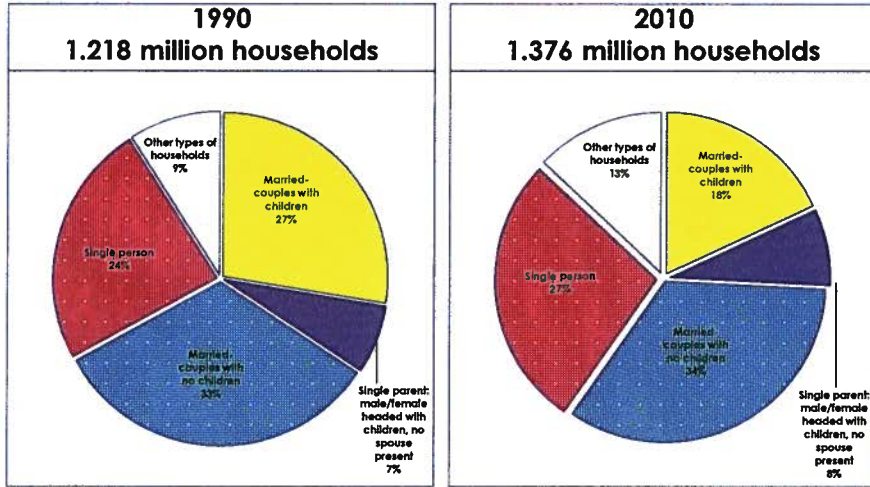

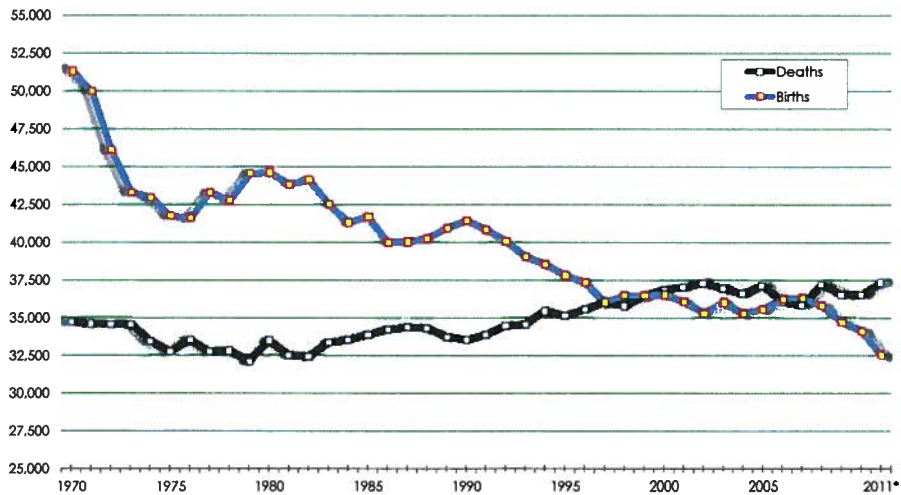
Types of Rural Pennsylvania Households, 1990-2010

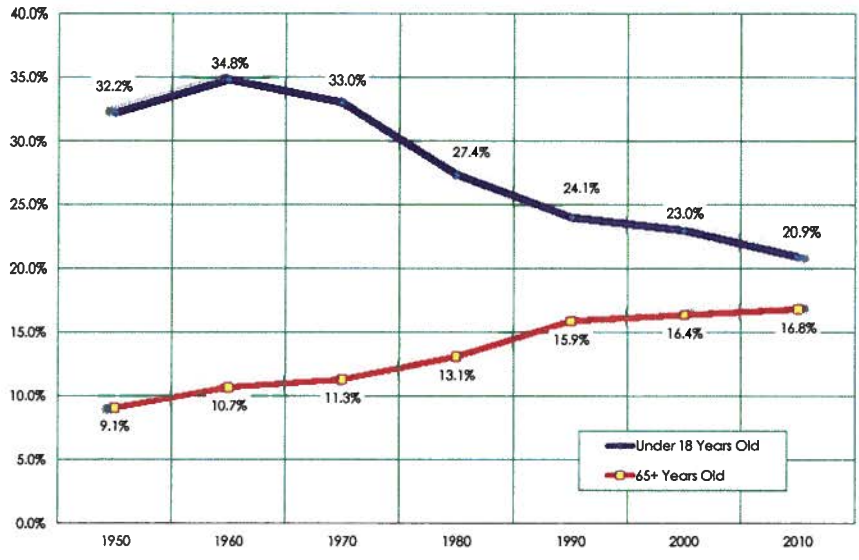
Number of Births and Deaths in Rural Pennsylvania, 1970 to 2011*

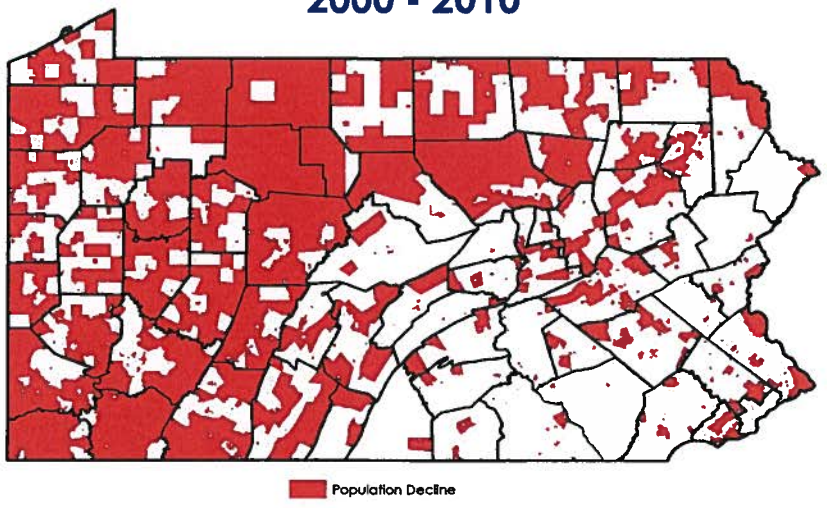
Children And Senior Citizens in Rural Pennsylvania, 1950 to 2010

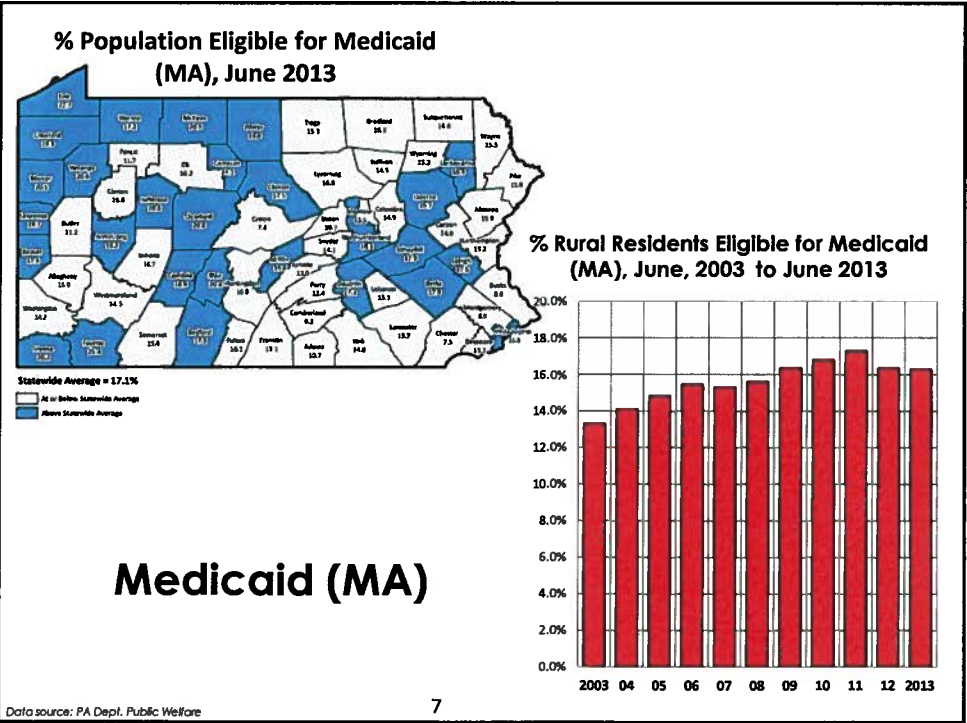
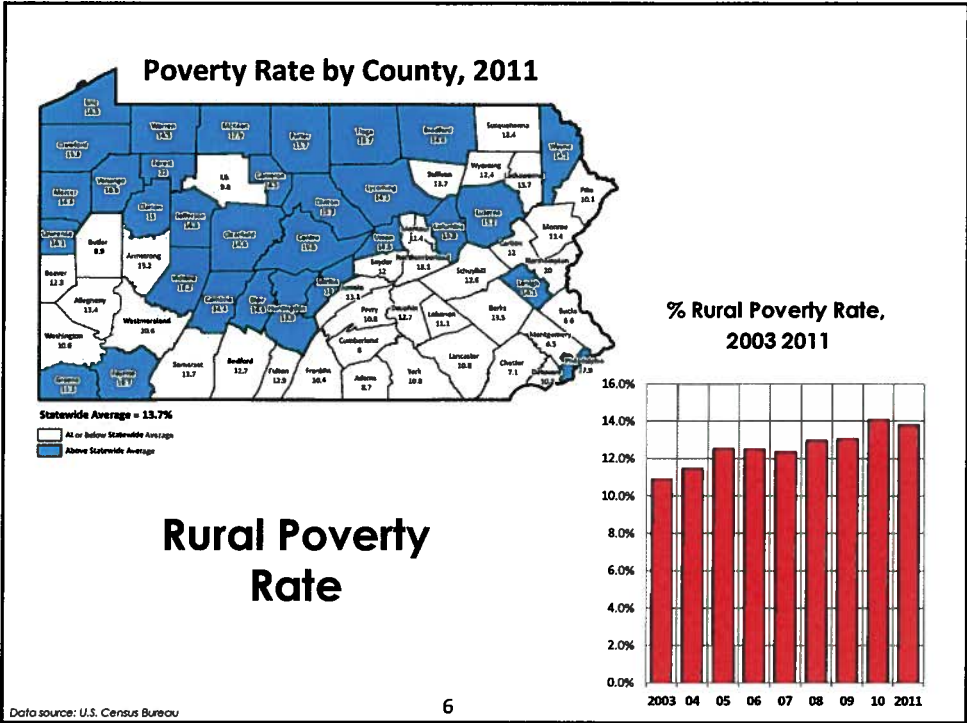

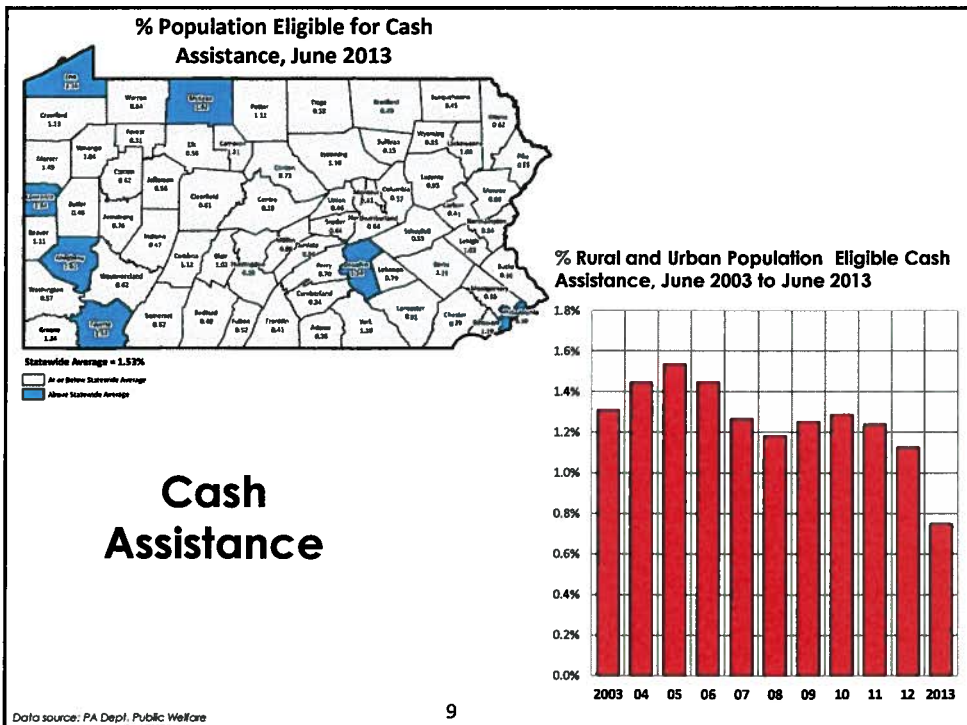
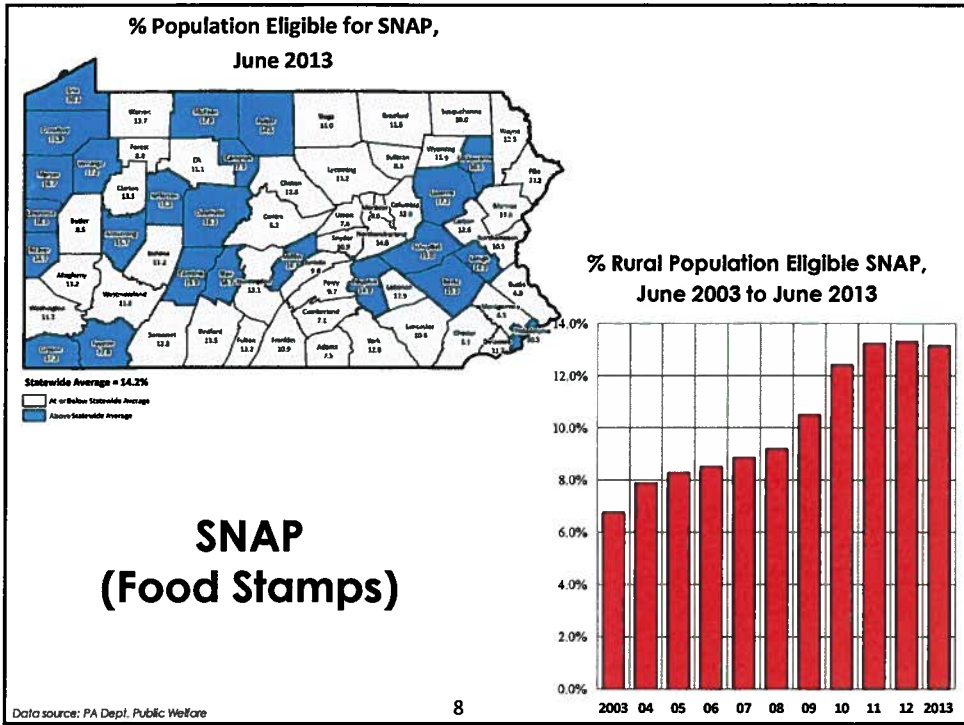
Pennsylvania Municipality Population Change, 2000 - 2010

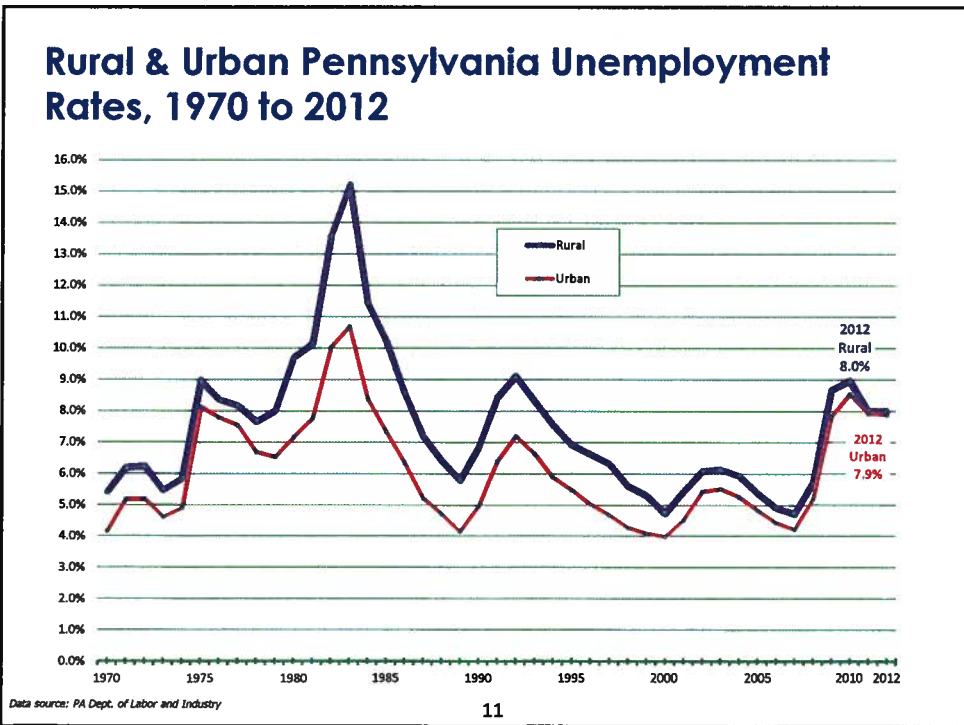
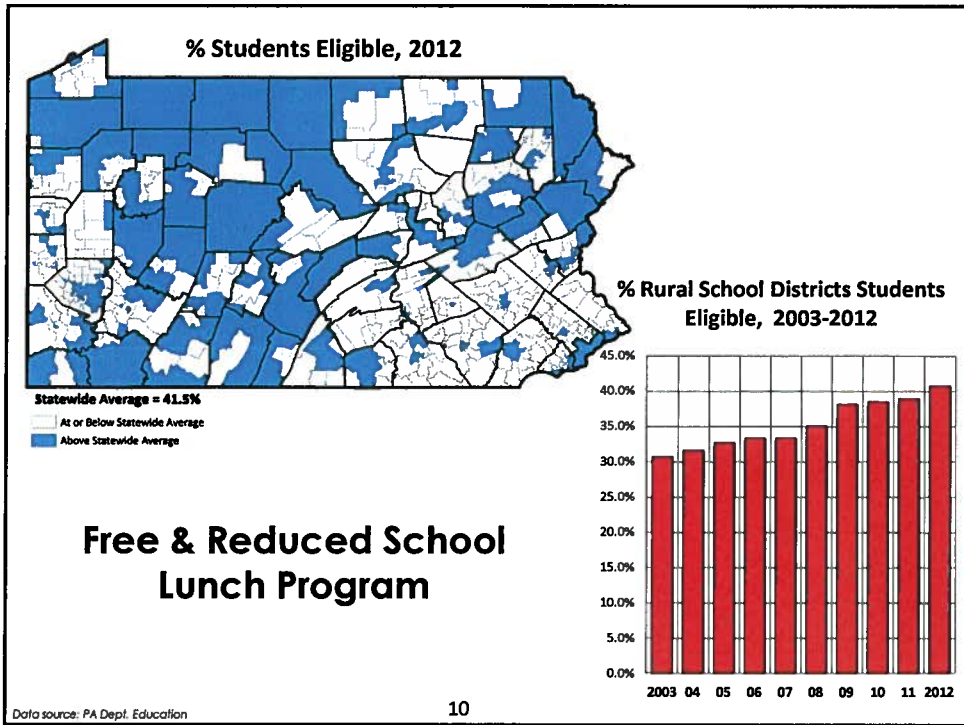

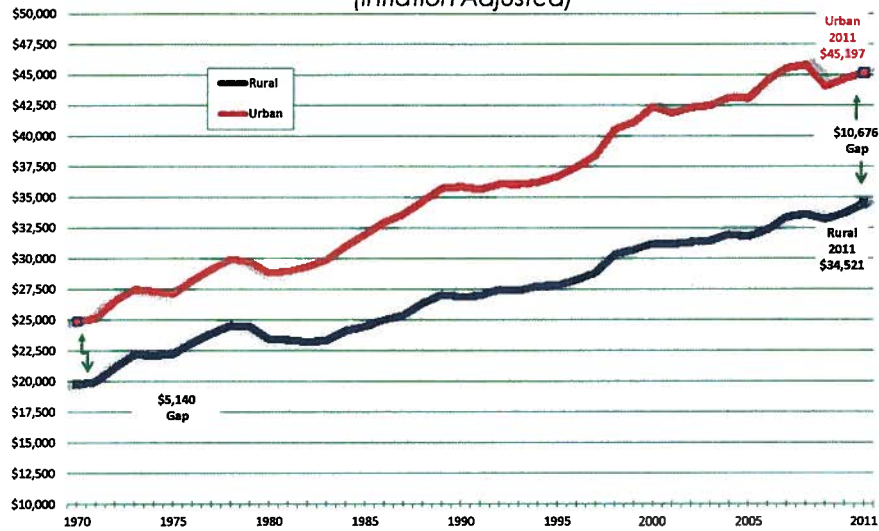






Per Capita Income in Rural and Urban Pennsylvania, 1970-2011

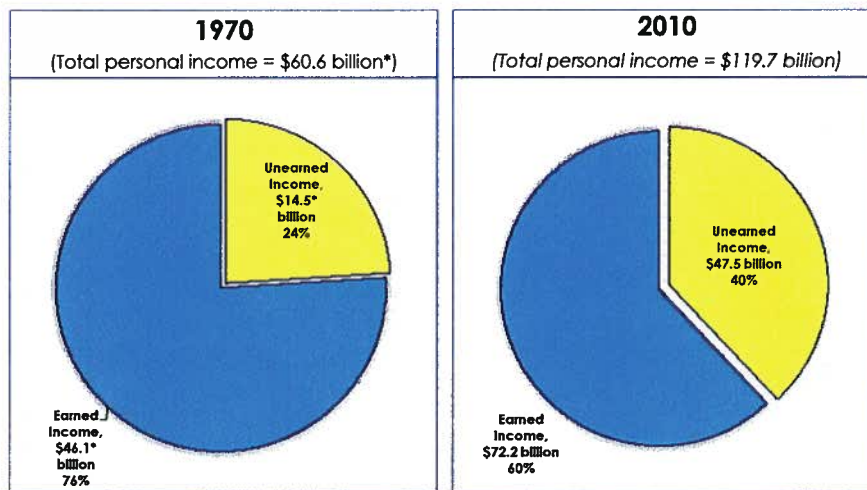

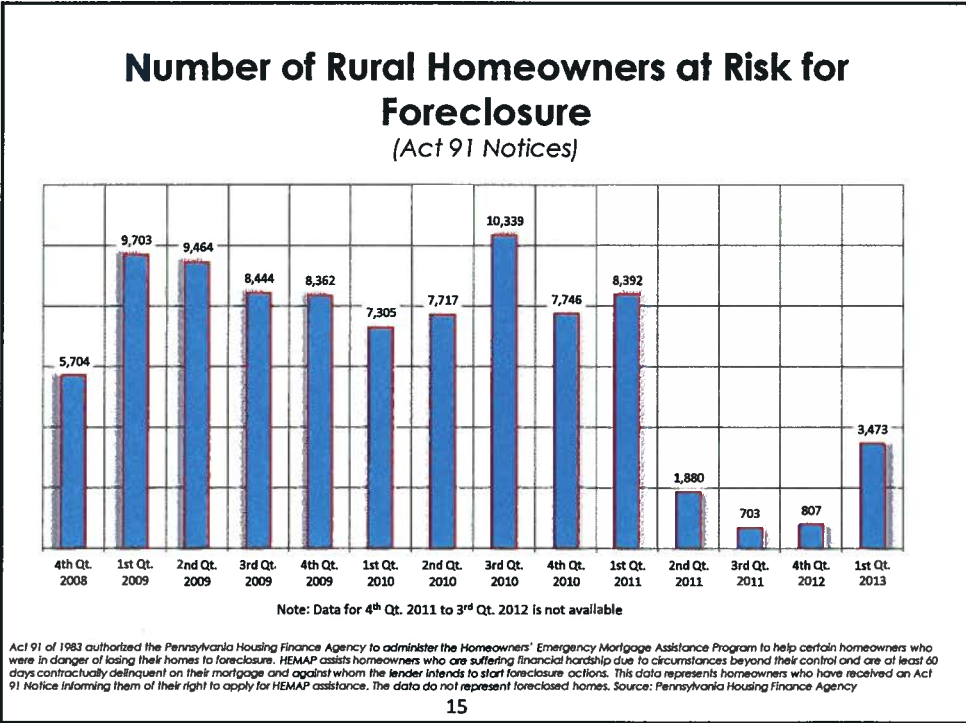
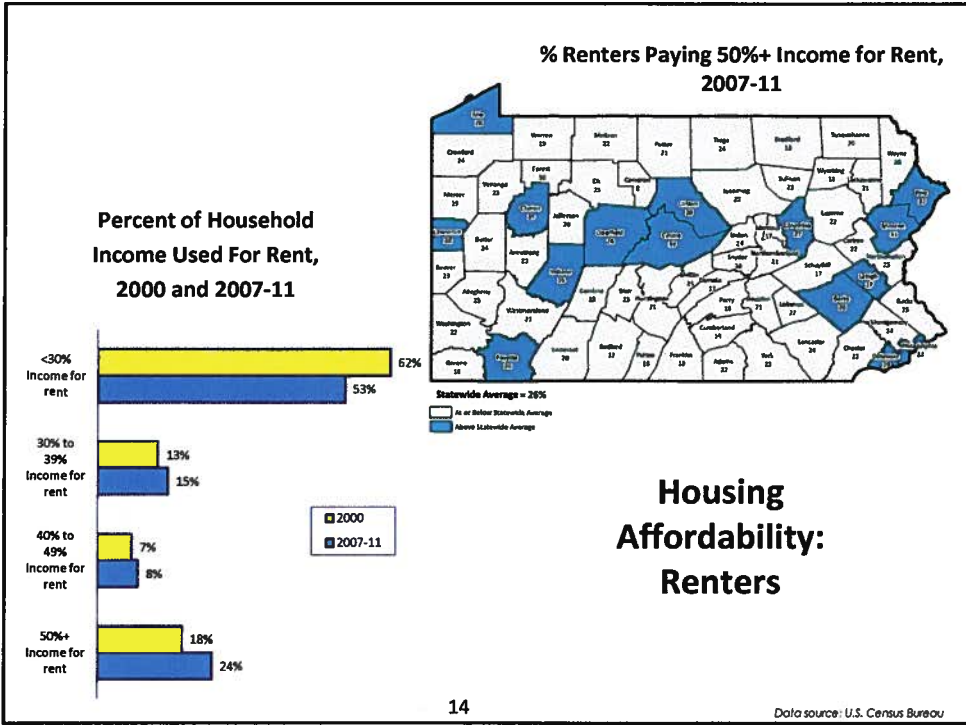

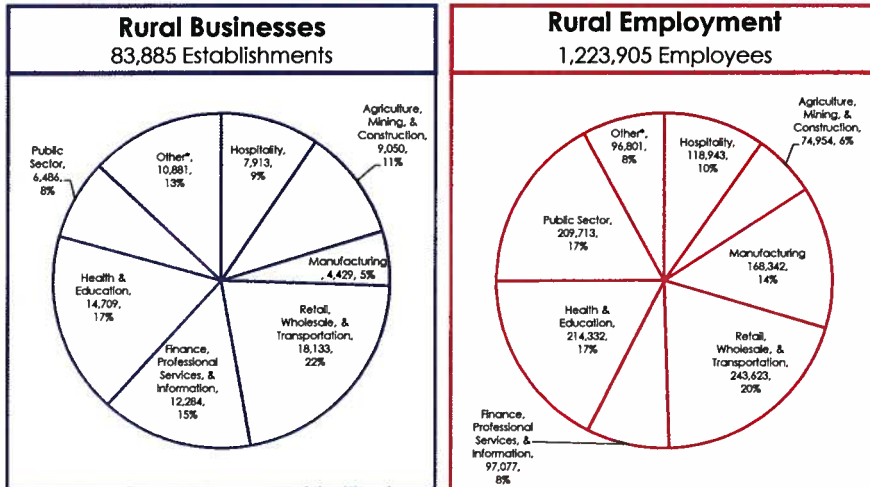

Businesses & Employment by Industry in Rural Pennsylvania, 2010

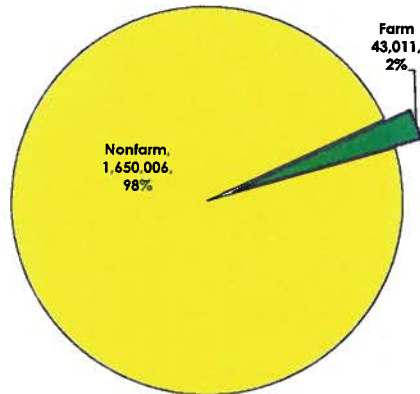

Counties With Ag sales of \$100 Million or More, 2010

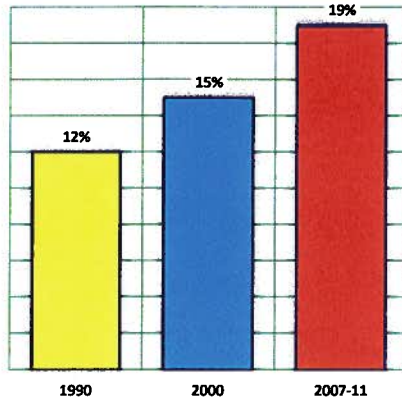

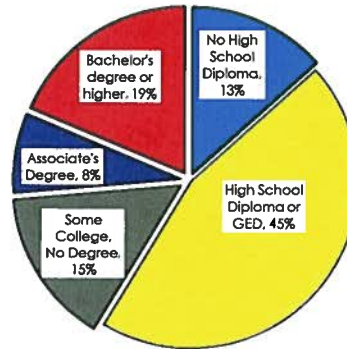

Highest Level of Adult Educational Attainment, 2007-2011

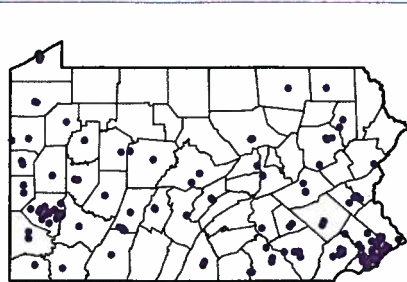

Postsecondary Institutions in Pennsylvania, 2011

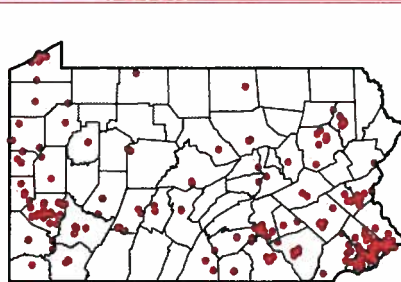
Non-Degree Granting Postsecondary Institutions (Trade & Technical Schools)
