



Sanofi Pasteur New Quality Facility (B75) Opened October 2016

- Sanofi is making a significant investment at the Sanofi Pasteur U.S. headquarters in Swiftwater to support the addition of facilities dedicated to new product manufacturing, production expansion, research and development, and quality testing.
- Our new Quality Facility was built to support the increasing volume of tests required by the continuous growth of existing products, while also welcoming all innovative analytical methods needed for our next generation of products such as our investigational *Clostridium difficile* and dengue vaccines.
- The facility will provide the testing support required for the new influenza production facility under construction at the east end of the campus. Without the new quality control capacity, the growth in our influenza production would not have been possible.
- The decision to locate this facility in Swiftwater results from the site's strong quality and compliance performance. The state-of-the-industry facility combines office and laboratory space, and will support the quality testing for the company's manufactured products.
- The new facility aligns with best-in-class design for laboratories, continuing to demonstrate Sanofi's commitment to safety, quality and the future of technology.
- Specifics on the Quality Facility:
 - \$64 million investment;
 - Approximately 200 jobs provided during construction;
 - Zero recordable safety incidents during entire construction period;
 - Three-level facility accommodating workspace for 240 employees;
 - Provides testing capabilities for products manufactured on site as well as testing capabilities for future growth.
